Get ready for **Eat Them to Defeat Them 2026** – and an exciting new mission for your pupils! We're looking for **Veg Hunter Champions**: confident, curious pupils ready to lead the charge and inspire others to try new veg.

Whether your oldest pupils are **Year 2 or Year 6**, this is a **brilliant leadership role** that builds confidence, teamwork and enthusiasm for healthy eating.

### Anytime from the 12<sup>th</sup> January onwards

Find the pupils who are ready for the challenge – to taste, explore and champion veg across your school.

There is a **lesson plan and an assembly** to help you motivate your older pupils to take on the challenge of leading the school and the caterers with this year's Eat Them to Defeat Them.

Once you have assembled your **Veg Hunter Champions**, it's time to let them talk to your school's catering team and start planning the veg hunting adventure! (see our Working with Caterers Guide online)

Plus, they also need to start organising the **Great Veg Vote**.



Your **Veg Hunter Champion team** could be assigned to **individual classes** to motivate, enthuse and engage the classes – nothing like a bit of healthy competition to inspire the older pupils. **OR** they could be **Veg Hunter Champions for individual vegetables** – the choice is yours or theirs! (more information, support and downloadable resources are available online) You can download, cut-out and colour-in Veg Hunter **badges** for your Champions - make sure they've got their badges on and are wearing them with pride.

Although you can run this at any time we recommend that by the **week of the 2<sup>nd</sup> February**, ensure that your Veg Hunter Champions are assembled and ready with their action plan.

- ✓ How are they going to be inspiring and promoting vegetables across the school? Plus maintaining the fun of Eat Them to Defeat Them.
- ✓ Are they working with the caterers? What are they going to be doing?
- ✓ Have they started a plan for decorated the lunch hall? See the decorations section online.
- ✓ Are they ready for the **Great Veg Vote**? There are lesson plans and downloadable resources to help with this all on the website

By **half term**, your Veg Hunter Champions need to be clear about the plans for Eat Them to Defeat Them in your school. The printed resources will be arriving after half term and your pupils can help you give out all the resources for each pupil too.
